The Tay is very like Tideway and the Tyne; a serious river to row on. It's surprising that there hasn't been a club on the Tay given how good a river it is. We do, however, have some evidence of a previous club; Perth Rowing Club. We have an old cup, the "PA" Trophy. Raced for in 1931 and 1932 according to the inscription. We think it was a skiff club, but can't really find out anything else.
